Processing the Background check takes 5-7 working days. However there are certain times of the year, fall and spring, when it can take 2-3 weeks to process the background check. If you are not sure you have a current background check on file, please call or stop by the school office and we will check your status.

## Dear Gordon Families:

We hear often that many of you want to help with PTA, but you don't have time or you are not sure what the PTA even does. We understand! And we would like to share with you some of what we do and what we are all about.

Q: What does the PTA do for Gordon?

A: The Accelerated Reader, Scholastic News and Reflex Math programs that your child's classroom uses were funded by the PTA. The PTA also gives grants to each teacher to purchase items for their classrooms. These are some of the largest budget items that the PTA funds. In the past the PTA has funded Lexia, and Accelerated Math as well, but unfortunately due to low fundraiser participation our budget could not cover these programs this year.

Q: How is my money used from all of these fundraisers?

A: Most goes to the above programs. It also sponsors fun activities for your children such as Passport Club, Fall Carnival, the 5K Fun Run, Family Fun Nights, STEM nights, Tie Dye Day, Popcorn Fridays, Gordon Gear and more. Without funding Gordon PTA cannot sponsor these activities.

Q: Are the members of the PTA Board paid?

A: No. Board members are volunteers and receive no financial compensation. In fact many hold full time jobs in addition to putting in the volunteer hours towards the operation of the PTA. Some may also be ninjas and secret agents.

Q: I don't have time to volunteer and I hate fundraisers, can I just write you a check?
