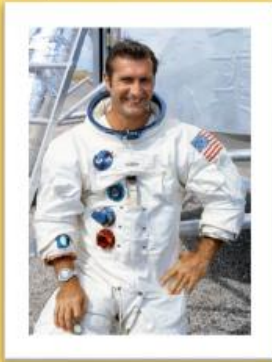
Music Minutes:
