Greetings Families!

March is here and Spring Conferences are fast approaching! This week, you should receive information from your child's teacher regarding conference scheduling on March 28-30. This conference marks the end of the second school trimester. Teachers will give parents their child's report card and go over their progress.

After spring vacation (4/2-4/6), we enter into our final trimester of learning. We also will begin state testing for grades 3-5. More information will be shared at the end of the month, with schedules for specific grade levels and how you can best support your students for spring learning.

Safety Update:

Elementary schools across our district are assessing safety protocols. For now, there are several ways you can help support safety efforts at school:

Send transportation changes with your child in the morning so teachers are notified in advance of any changes.

If you have last minute changes, please call no later than 3:30pm (M,T,TH,F) & 2:30pm (W).

Schedule classroom visits with teachers two days prior allowing teachers advance notice

School starts at 9:20. When dropping your child off for school in the morning, allow plenty of travel time as gates are closed before 9:20. The entry door in the drop off area is locked promptly at 9:20. If you arrive after the gates are closed, you will need to drive to the front of the school, park and come in to the office and sign your child in.

Please review and update your contact information-emergency information so we have up to date phone numbers in the event of an emergency.

<u>Absences</u>

Schools across the state and district are becoming increasingly accountable for student attendance, both excused and unexcused. Eighteen absences are considered "chronic" as it averages 2 days of missed school each month.

While we appreciate consistent attendance, please do keep your children home when they are sick. This has been a rough year for flu bugs and viruses! We miss students when they are absent yet we want our students to stay home and get well! Please provide documentation to the office of Doctor visits.

If you are planning a trip, please complete the Pre-Approved form in the office one week prior to your trip. This allows teachers and parent's time to communicate assignments so important skills can be maintained. While we recognize special trips with family can provide enriching experiences, successful school experiences and quality education cannot be duplicated in worksheets or provided on computer programs. Students do miss valuable learning and parents are encouraged to talk with teachers regarding the work they are missing. We are required by law to send letters to parents when students are missing school, even excused absences. If you do get a letter, please know we are trying to partner with you and raise awareness around your child's absences. We always want to help remove any barriers to your child attending school. If we can be of assistance, please contact myself or Jennifer Seemueller, our school counselor.
