Student Picture Day, Tuesday, September 26th

Picking up Students during School Hours

If you need to pick up a student during the school day, you will need to stop in the office to sign your child out. To maximize student learning, your child will not be called out of class until you arrive at school to sign him/her out. The office staff will call the classroom and ask that your child be sent to meet you in the office. If a student leaves after 2:30 and before 3:50 dismissal, it is recorded as tardy. If you know that your student needs to be released early, please send a note to your child's teacher.

Welcome Back!

I hope you all had a happy and healthy summer break. My goal is that all children experience an active and successful experience in PE, and leave the gym happy.

Since the grade levels I teach include Kindergarten through Eighth, although the concepts taught will be quite similar, the instructional methods vary quite a bit. At all grade levels we work on: being nice to each other, following the rules of the activity, good sportsmanship, working as a team member, active participation, and listening to teacher cues.

Over the first month of the school year we will cover throwing and catching, jumping rope, cooperative games and a variety of stretches and exercises.

In the month of October we will continue to focus on four components of fitness including; cardiorespiratory (jogging, prolonged physical activity), flexibility (stretching), muscular strength (push-ups, crunches, climbing rock wall), muscular endurance (trying to continue even though you may want to stop).

Please encourage your children to dress appropriately for PE days. What that means is “play clothes” and comfortable shoes. Remember that when wearing a skirt or dress on PE days to wear shorts as well. Thanks

Gordon Elementary Drop-off & Pick-up

Here are some guidelines to help with Gordon student pick up and drop off transition times to ensure a simple and easy experience for everyone. See map below for quick reference.

- Please be patient, kind, and courteous of everyone.
- No parking in the pick-up circle from 8:45am-9:30am and 2:45pm-4:15pm as posted. Please stay with your vehicle and continue to pull forward as the drop off information sign indicates. This is especially important in the morning to help all students get to class on time.
- If you would like to escort your child inside please park accordingly and walk your child(ren) to the front of the school. Please do not allow children to walk through the parking lot without an adult.
- When exiting the parking lot during pick- up or drop- off hours please do NOT attempt to make a right hand turn at the stop sign into the circle, this is for the safety of everyone.



End of Day Pick-up

Roundabout-Car Pick-Up: Students will wait in their alphabetic area until you get them within the circle. Please pull forward in the circle. Staff will be supervising and releasing students into your car.

If you are walking to pick-up your child: Please park your car in the designated parking areas and walk on the sidewalk around the school to the covered area by the gym. Staff will be supervising and releasing students.
